KAVEL HEADSTONE

Work will begin in early November on repair of the August Kavel headstone in the cemetery. The headstone has been cracking for many years and the work to be done will prevent further cracking in the slate. A plaster cast of the headstone will also be taken, so that in the future an exact copy can be accurately made if the headstone starts to deteriorate again. We will be using funding from the SA History Fund and a Barossa Council heritage grant to pay for the work, which will be undertaken by master stonemason Christian Frenzel, currently working at Rowland Flat and who is also involved with helping to restore Notre Dam cathedral in Paris. The Admin. Team secured this funding last year so the work will not impact on the budget. For more information contact Phil Hiscock, Don Ross or Ev Leske who are supervising this work.
