'HYMNSING'

A new music resource that encourages hymn singing and makes 'the old favourites' more accessible has been launched. 'Hymnsing' comprises easy-to-access videos of Lutheran hymns with the words on screen as they appear in the LCA hymnbook, led by professional musicians in a worship setting.

Pastor Adrian Kitson is part of the Hymnsing team. 'For years I've known that people across Australia and New Zealand love to sing their faith together in their local church. Over recent years this has become increasingly difficult. There are fewer musicians available to support congregations in song. The online hymns available are often presented by churches with very different musical heritage and style. It's highlighted the fact that, even without social distancing restrictions, there are many people unable to experience the joy of singing songs of faith together. For these reasons, the time felt right for this project, which allows people to see and hear talented musicians playing the hymns they love clearly and simply.

He said Hymnsing videos could be used in a variety of settings. These include family members or professional carers who support people with disabilities, local faith communities who have no musicians to support community singing, and individuals and families.

Hymnsing is free to access via the internet on YouTube and CDs and DVDs are available to purchase through hymnsing.com.au, where you can also support the project financially so that more hymn videos can be added to the collection.

MESSAGE TO ALL WHO COME TO WORSHIP AT LANGMEIL

COVID-19 LANGMEIL UPDATE – AS AT 6TH AUGUST 2020

You will notice several changes when you next come to worship.

Following Ministry Team and Worship Team meetings, the ongoing safety of our worshipers was discussed and the following changes have been implemented.

1. The pulpit has been removed and the band has been relocated to provide sufficient space for us to allow the safe celebration of communion.
2. The spacing of the pews has been changed to provide 1.5 metres between them, thus making it easier for all family groups to maintain the required 1.5 metre 'Social Distancing' as currently directed by the government.
3. Communion – we have made the following changes:
 - We will practise continuous communion
 - There will be no common cup – each person will have an individual cup
 - The ushers will control the flow of participants
 - We will commence with the back row, one side at a time (to minimise any cross-over of people), with participants walking to the front, receiving the bread and then the wine. They will then exit via the side door, place their used cup in the bin outside the door and make their way back to their seat via the passageway, Fellowship Hall and re-enter the church via The Link.
 - Those who practise intinction will have to pick up an individual cup of wine to dip their bread. They can empty the unused wine into a chalice just inside the side door.

Note – as per normal - communion will be brought to those who are mobility-challenged. We request that those who require this sit at the aisle end of the pew and let the usher know of your request.

'Social Distancing' – we remind worshipers of the need to maintain 'Social Distancing of 1.5 metres' between family group at all times – including before, during and after worship. Thus we request that you do not gather in the Fellowship Hall before and after service. To assist with this, we have decided to suspend serving of coffee and tea.

We thank you for your patience and understanding of these changes as we do our best to protect all those who gather for worship.

Please raise any concerns you may have with either myself or Pastor.
