#### One Church, two practices of ordination

On 22 September 2023, the General Church Board and College of Bishops approved three Way Forward frameworks for distribution across the LCANZ.

These were recommended by the Way Forward project team, using a robust evaluation and selection system, following the call for models from across the church.

Three webinars have been organised to allow all members of the church to learn more about the three frameworks and the selection and evaluation process and provide feedback to the Way Forward team.
