AUST. LUTHERAN COLLEGE has occupied its current site at North
Adelaide since 1968. The campus has now become surplus to its require-
ments, which have changed dramatically over the past 5 years due to the
closure of its tertiary boarding facility, the pandemic, decline in enrolments
and the implementation of ALC's learning model, which sees students
completing their studies in their local setting.
To ensure the College's ongoing viability, the Board has entered into
discussions with the LCAZ regarding relocating to fit-for-purpose
premises that are cheaper to maintain.
While no alternative site has been identified at this stage, the College
intends to commence the immense task of decommissioning the North
Adelaide campus asap and is seeking an Adelaide based volunteer with
demonstrated experience in project management to lead this project.
