## **SOUTHERN BAROSSA LUTHERAN CHURCHES**

### **- GOOD FRIDAY INFORMATION -**

The message of Good Friday is for all people. The day is especially significant for those who have been drawn to Christ Jesus. It is in Christ alone that hearts burdened by failures, shame and sin find comfort and healing. Christ has made peace between us and our heavenly Father. He accomplished this peace through the blood of his cross.

Jesus, the Saviour of all humanity, also came willingly to carry the burden of our being sinned against.

He has taken the sin of all people on himself. His love for all people is seen clearly in the events and by his actions on Good Friday. His love for all people is also very evident by his words throughout his arrest, appearing before Annas, Caiaphas and Pontius Pilate, and especially by what he said while on the cross.

Good Friday is a day like no other! We have good reason to come together, to hear the life-saving message of Christ Jesus, and to worship the one true and living God.

**This Good Friday there will be the opportunity to worship at one, two, or each of the three significant times that we are told about in Scripture.**

#### **9:00am - at TABOR**

Known as 'the third hour' of the day in Jewish time. This is the hour of the day that Jesus was crucified.

This service will bring into view what took place from Jesus' arrest in Gethsemane (John 18:1-11; Matthew 26:45-56), the illegal trial by the Jewish elders and teachers of the law, led by Annas and Caiaphas (John 18:12-24; Matthew 26:57-68) to Jesus before Pontius Pilate (John 18:28-19:16) and being handed over to be crucified.



#### **12:00pm - at LANGMEIL**

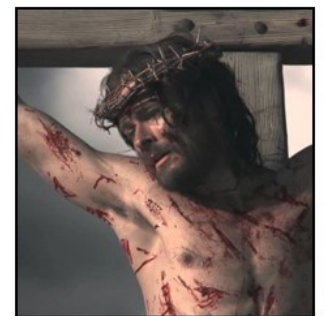
Known as the sixth hour of the day in Jewish time. This is the hour of the day that the sun stopped shining and darkness was over the whole land for the next three hours.

This service will focus particularly on Christ's crucifixion (John 19:16-27; Matthew 27:32-44; Mark 15:21-32; Luke 23:26-43).

#### **3:00pm - at GRACE-ST PAUL'S**

Known as the ninth hour of the day in Jewish time. This is the hour of Jesus' death! Words spoken by Jesus at this time are recorded by the evangelists Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. This service will also bring into view Jesus burial and include times for personal reflection.

The golden tapestry of God's love for you in Christ will shine through each service. Jesus was lifted up so that all who believe in him may have eternal life!



There won't be people greeting prior to the services, and you will be welcome to stay in the church for a time of silent meditation at the conclusion of each service.

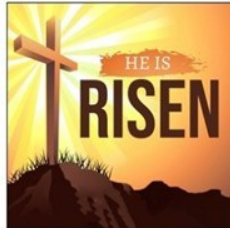
All three services will include the sacrament of Holy Communion. This is the day that you were engraved on the palms of God's hands, when Christ opened heaven for you by his death on the cross. Come and receive God's forgiveness and peace in Word and through receiving Christ's body and blood in the Lord's Supper.
