Working with Children Check (WWCC) <https://www.sa.gov.au/topics/rights-and-law/rights-and-responsibilities> It's an offence to do child-related work without a WWCC. It is required if you work, or intend to work, as an employee/volunteer, in a child-related area. WWCCs are valid for 5 years. You can [apply for a new WWCC check](#) if your existing check will expire within 6 months.

Life on the Far Side: Adventures Undergone while Investigating a Forgotten Past

Speaker: John Strehlow

The meeting can be viewed at a later date as well. \$5 donation, supper, all welcome. Biographer, playwright, theatre director, and set designer, John Strehlow was born in 1946 in Adelaide, into a family closely involved with Aboriginal people for three generations. He began researching his grandparents' two-volume biography, The Tale of Frieda Keysser, in earnest in 1994, publishing the first volume in 2011 and the second volume late in 2019. When John Strehlow embarked on a book about his family, The Tale of Frieda Keysser, he had no idea what he was letting himself in for. Investigating a Forgotten Past gives the inside story in a nuts-and-bolts outline of the 25-year project. Copies of the eBook will be on sale on the evening, and it is hoped a Print on Demand copy may also be available.
