Biographer, playwright, theatre director, and set designer, John Strehlow was born in1946 in Adelaide, into a family closely involved with Aboriginal people for three generations. He began researching his grandparents' two-volume biography, The Tale of Frieda Keysser, in earnest in 1994, publishing the first volume in 2011 and the second volume late in 2019. When John Strehlow embarked on a book about his family, The Tale of Frieda Keysser, he had no idea what he was letting himself in for. Investigating a Forgotten Past gives the inside story in a nuts-and-bolts outline of the 25-year project. Copies of the eBook will be on sale on the evening, and it is hoped a Print on Demand copy may also be available.
