Safe Church - Child Safe Information

The LCA has a three-stage process to enable continuous improvement of child safety. Congregations are asked to review how they meet the Child Safety Standards every three years by undertaking the following steps:

- 1. Self-Assessment
- 2. Development of Child Safety Standards Action Plan
- 3. Implementation of Child Safety Standards Action Plan. Implementation of the Child Safety Standards is compulsory for all Australian congregations. Church Council is responsible for making this happen. Each of the ten LCA Child Safety Standards has several elements that act as indicators regarding what needs to be in place to meet the standard. Self-Assessment is a way to measure and see how your congregation is going and using the indicators. It is like doing a child safety 'health check'.
