

There were 279 voting members present. Thank you for the great attendance.

The members present passed a vote to Call Pastor Stephen Schultz. The members also passed a 'Contingent Call' to Pastor Phil Joppich, should Stephen Schultz decline the call.

Bishop Andrew has advised Stephen of the Call. Stephen has 4 weeks to prayerfully consider our Call and respond. If Stephen accepts the Call, it can take around 3 months to join us. If Stephen declines the Call, we will immediately issue a Call to Phil Joppich.

Governance Council

2025 Annual Report

In keeping with “Framing our Vision for the Future” document produced and agreed to in 2023, the following report is provided for the 2025 year.

Members of the Governance Council were again endorsed at individual congregational meetings and continued to provide input into the strategy previously put in place.

Budgets were provided by Dean Hoklas at the beginning of 2025, showing the costs associated with supporting either one Pastor (\$144, 000) or two Pastors (\$278,000)

A Unified Digital Member Directory was produced with the assistance of each congregation and made available to those on the Governance Council and Ministry Team to improve accessibility to members. This will be used as the basis for the directory after the amalgamation.

Children’s Ministry information was gathered by the Ministry Team to produce a list of member’s children between the ages of 3&14 to begin a review process

Current ministries were listed by the Ministry Team for ongoing discussion

Confirmation classes proved exceptionally well attended with 23 young people undertaking a course led by Rachel Brown and her team, with assistance from Pastor Brian Schwarz

Pastor Paul Kerber completed his term as Interim Pastor with us on April 30th 2025

Assistant Bishop Mark Schultz presented a session to the Governance Council and Ministry Team in May, outlining the steps he took in forming a new congregation in both Sydney and overseas and encouraging all to continue our journey while never losing sight of the ministry opportunities

Ministry Team joined the Governance Council in May to bring greater input into the important discussions around working toward amalgamation. These joint meetings will continue until voting is held on this matter

A Member Survey was prepared in consultation with the LCA SA/NT District to look at expectations of individual members as we move forward and with opportunity to comment on the skills required of a Pastor prior to a “Call” being placed

Assistant Bishop, Stephen Schultz, presented a Survey overview to all present at a Joint Service on August 31

Assistant Bishop, Stephen Schultz, presented a detailed review of the Survey to the Governance Council, Ministry Team and members of individual Church Councils

Q & A sessions were held following the results of the Survey

An Action Timeline was developed and presented to members

We look forward in anticipation to continuing the journey of being part of an exciting ministry opportunity as one congregation.
